## REGULATIONS

GOVERNING THE

## UNIFORMING OF EMPLOYEES

Effective April 1, 1929

Superseding all previous rules and instructions  
inconsistent therewith.

The regulations herein set forth govern employes specified of THE LONG ISLAND RAILROAD required to wear uniform clothing.

## REGULATIONS.

1a. The following employes, while on duty, are required to wear the uniform prescribed for their respective grades of service, viz.:

- Assistant Baggage Foremen
- Assistant Station Masters
- Baggage Checkmen
- Baggage Foremen
- Business Car Porters
- Gatemen
- Passenger Directors
- Train Announcers
- Parcel Room Attendants
- Passenger Brakemen
- Passenger Conductors
- Station Masters
- Station Porters (Red Cap)
- Ticket Examiners
- Toilet Room Attendants
- Train Porters (Colored)

### GENERAL OFFICE EMPLOYES.

- Elevator Operators
- Telegraph Messengers

1b. The following employes, while on duty, are required to wear the uniforms prescribed for their respective grades of service where the conditions determine—to be decided by the Superintendent or other proper authority:

- Assistant Baggage Agents
- Baggage Agents
- Baggage Clerks
- Bureau of Information Attendants
- Elevator Attendants
- Janitors

- Letter Carriers or Mail Messengers (R. R. S.)
- Messengers (Colored) (outside General Office)
- Porters (Cleaners)
- Station Agents
- Station Baggage men (Baggage and Mail Porters)
- Station Cleaners
- Station Masters' Clerks
- Telegraph Messengers
- Ticket Agents
- Ticket Clerks
- Ticket Sellers

### POLICE DEPARTMENT EMPLOYES.

- Captains
- Lieutenants
- Patrolmen
- Sergeants
- Watchmen

Other employes required to be specially or partially uniformed will wear such clothing or portions of uniform and have such designations as may be assigned them by Superintendents or other proper authority.

2. The complete garments, involving cloth and other materials, and the labor of manufacture, will be contracted for by the Railroad Company. All uniforms will be made of the cloths and materials of the standards adopted and prescribed for each of the various grades of employes.

3. The standard uniform shall consist of a coat, a vest and trousers, a cap (with suitable storm cover, when requested), and, in winter, of an overcoat for such grades of employes who require an overcoat in discharge of their duties.

4. Ornaments and buttons will be furnished by the Company free of charge to employes, and their attachment to the garments is included in the contract for manufacture. Should employes leave the service from any cause they will be required to return the buttons and ornaments to their employing officer.

5. The cloth and other materials and the workmanship embraced in the uniform garments for the Company's use will be examined by an inspector appointed by the Company, to determine that every detail is absolutely correct and according to specifications, and each garment so approved will bear the impression of his stamp.

6. Employes shall pay one-half of the cost of materials and manufacture for such uniform clothing as they are *required by regulation* to wear while on duty, including overcoats and summer garments, except that employes dismissed from the Company's service for cause, or those leaving of their own volition, before completing payments, shall be required to pay the full cost.

7. Employes while on duty will wear their coats buttoned, except Passenger Trainmen when actually engaged in lifting transportation.

8. All requisitions for uniform clothing must be made by the Superintendent, or other proper authority, on blank forms provided for the purpose, and forwarded to the Purchasing Agent. The full name of the employe must be shown on the requisitions; example, "John H. Smith."

9. Payments for clothing furnished may be made by employes in installments, as follows:

Full suit—In three monthly payments;

Coat or Overcoat—In two monthly payments;

Vest and Trousers—In two monthly payments;

All other uniform

garments or articles—In one payment.

10. Collections (or deductions from payrolls) will be made by Superintendents or other proper authority, and remitted in strict compliance with the instructions issued from time to time. Checks must be made payable to the order of the Long Island Railroad Company.

11. Uniformed employes must wear black leather shoes, black neckties, cuffs, and either stiff or semi-stiff white linen collars; shirt of light color; no solid colors except white. (White collars need not be worn with blue flannel shirts.)

12. Uniforms made of standard blue serge, over the specifications prescribed for the respective blue cloth uniforms, may be worn between May 15th and October 14th, inclusive, by employes required to wear blue uniform coats; but blue serge uniform garments must not be worn in conjunction with blue cloth uniform garments.

Standard light weight mohair coats may be worn from May 15th to October 14th, inclusive, by employes required to wear blue or cadet-grey uniform coats, and they may be worn all year by Ticket Office employes.

13. Clothing and other dress material must be kept in good condition by the employes, so that they will present a neat appearance when on duty. Superintendents and other proper authority must have frequent inspection of the uniforms made while employes are on duty, and see that renewals of uniform clothing are made when in their judgment it is necessary.

14. When measurements are to be made, employes will be sent to the point designated by the proper authority.

15. Superintendents or other proper authority will communicate promptly with the Purchasing Agent in regard to faults in uniforms furnished, disposition of unclaimed uniforms, delays in furnishing uniforms, and matters of such character.

16. In case of dissatisfaction with a garment on the part of an employe, it shall be tried on in the presence of a representative of the Contractor and the immediate superior of the employe, and when pronounced satisfactory by them, it will be accepted. If they are unable to agree, the matter shall be referred to the Purchasing Agent, and his decision on the question shall be final.

17. At stations in charge of Station Agents, station employes competent to give proper information to patrons must wear the prescribed uniform cap while on duty outside of the office.

18. Only standard blue raincoats may be worn by uniformed employes while on duty. (These raincoats will be furnished to employes only at full cost.)

## CLOTHING MATERIALS.

19. Standard clothing materials adopted and prescribed for use are as follows:

### BLUE CLOTH—(Blue Kersey).

Pure indigo dye.

All wool.

Weight—16 oz. to the yard.

### BLUE SERGE—(Wanskuck).

Fast dye.

All wool.

Weight—12 or 16 oz. to the yard  
(at option of employe).

### CADET-GREY CLOTH.

Pure indigo dye.

All wool.

Weight—14 oz. or 22 oz. to the yard  
(at option of employe).

### DARK GREY WORSTED WHIP CORD CLOTH.

Fast color.

All wool.

Weight—16 oz. to the yard.

### BLACK CLOTH—(Unfinished Worsted).

Fast color.

All wool.

Weight—13 oz. to the yard.

### IRISH FRIEZE.

Fast color.

All wool.

Weight—32 oz. to the yard.

### BLUE FLANNEL—(Shirting Flannel).

Paca blue.

All wool.

Weight—10 oz. to the yard.

**BLACK SICILIAN MOHAIR.**

Imported black Sicilian (mohair).  
Fast color.  
Light weight.

**GREY MOHAIR.**

Grey Gibraltar (mohair).  
Fast color.  
Light weight.

**WHITE DUCK.**

Sea Island, or equal.  
Weight—8 oz. to the yard.

**WHITE TWILL.**

Bleached twill.  
80 threads to warp.  
38 threads to filling.  
Weight—2.68 yards to the pound.

**BLUE DENIM.**

Best quality Eastern.  
Weight—2.20 yards to the pound.

**PIN CHECK DENIM.**

Best quality Eastern.  
Weight—2.20 yards to the pound.

**DOUBLE WARP BLACK SERGE LINING.**

Strength test—57 lbs. to the warp.  
43 lbs. to the filling.  
Weight—7 oz. to the yard.

**REPELLANT LINING.**

All wool  
Strength test—35 lbs. to the warp.  
20 lbs. to the filling.  
Weight—13½ oz. to the yard.

**GARMENTS.**

20. Standard garments adopted and prescribed for use are as follows:

**COATS.****DOUBLE-BREADED FROCK.**

Standard blue cloth; roll collar, lapel about ten (10) inches long; one outside breast pocket on left side, two inside breast pockets, two plait pockets inside of black skirt; either gilt or nickel collar ornaments and buttons—four buttons on each breast, two buttons on each sleeve, one button at top and one at bottom on the side edges in plaits of skirt, or a total of four.

**DOUBLE-BREADED SACK NO. 1.**

Standard blue cloth, standard cadet-grey cloth, or standard blue serge; roll collar, lapel about ten (10) inches long; one outside breast pocket on left side, two outside lower pockets, two outside cash pockets, two inside breast pockets, and two inside ticket pockets; either gilt or nickel collar ornaments and buttons—four buttons on each breast, and two buttons on each sleeve.

**DOUBLE-BREADED SACK NO. 2.**

Standard blue cloth, or standard blue serge; roll collar, lapel about ten (10) inches long; one outside breast pocket on left side, two outside lower pockets, one outside cash pocket on right side, and two inside breast pockets; either gilt or nickel collar ornaments and buttons—four buttons on each breast, and two buttons on each sleeve.

**SINGLE-BREASTED SACK NO. 1.**

Standard blue cloth, standard blue serge, or standard grey cloth; roll collar, lapel about eight (8) inches long; one outside breast pocket on left side, two outside lower pockets with flaps, and one inside breast pocket; either gilt or nickel collar ornaments and buttons—four buttons on the breast, and two buttons on each sleeve.

**SINGLE-BREASTED SACK NO. 2.**

Standard black Sicilian mohair; roll collar; one outside breast pocket on left side, two outside lower pockets, two outside cash pockets, two inside breast pockets, and two inside ticket pockets; either gilt or nickel collar ornaments and buttons—three buttons on the breast; sleeves without buttons or vents.

**SINGLE-BREASTED SACK NO. 3.**

Standard black Sicilian mohair; roll collar; two outside lower pockets, and two inside breast pockets; either gilt or nickel collar ornaments and buttons—three buttons on the breast; sleeves without buttons or vents.

**SINGLE-BREASTED SACK NO. 4.**

Standard black Sicilian mohair; long roll collar; two outside lower pockets, and one inside lower pocket on left side; gilt collar ornaments; two gilt buttons on the breast; sleeves without buttons or vents.

**SINGLE-BREASTED SACK NO. 5.**

Standard grey mohair; roll collar; two outside lower pockets, and one outside breast pocket on left side; nickel collar ornaments; three nickel buttons on the breast; sleeves without buttons or vents.

**SINGLE-BREASTED BELTED SACK.**

Standard dark grey worsted whip cord cloth; yoke back, with belt reaching to side seams—stitched flat; roll collar, lapel about 10" long; two outside pockets with flaps, and one inside breast pocket; four nickel buttons on the breast; and white silk embroidered collar and breast ornaments.

**DOUBLE-BREASTED BLOUSE.**

Standard blue cloth, or standard blue serge; slit at both sides to permit access to back trousers pockets; two inside breast pockets; military style collar; either gilt or nickel collar ornaments and buttons—five buttons on each breast in shield design, and two buttons on each sleeve; badge loops on left breast.

**SINGLE-BREASTED BLOUSE NO. 1.**

Standard cadet-grey cloth; fly front, buttoned to neck; standing collar, with band of black mohair braid; two inside breast pockets, the right one horizontal and the left perpendicular; seven black bone buttons on the breast; sleeves having one inch band of black mohair braid, and without buttons or vents.

**SINGLE-BREASTED BLOUSE NO. 2.**

Standard white twill, or standard white duck; military style collar; square corners; without pockets; either gilt or nickel buttons, five on the breast, attached through eyelets by rings.

**SINGLE-BREASTED SACK JUMPER.**

Standard pin check denim; rolled notched lapel collar; square corners; seamed back; dark blue trimming on cuffs, also covering outside of collar and lapels, and a two inch strip of this material down the front edges and around the bottom edge of the garment; one outside patch pocket on right breast, two lower outside patch pockets, one outside patch pocket for watch on left breast, and one inside patch pocket on right side; five nickel buttons attached through eyelets by rings.

**SINGLE-BREASTED JUMPER.**

Standard blue denim, or standard pin check denim; roll collar, buttoned closely to neck, military style; square corners; seamed back; dark blue trimming on cuffs, also covering outside of collar, and a two inch strip of this material down the front edges of the garment; one outside patch pocket on right breast, two lower outside patch pockets, one outside patch pocket for watch on left breast, and one inside patch pocket on right side; five nickel buttons attached through eyelets by rings.

**VESTS.****SINGLE-BREASTED NO. 1.**

Standard blue cloth, standard blue serge, standard cadet-grey cloth, or standard dark grey worsted whip cord cloth; without collar; four outside pockets with welts, and one inside breast pocket; vest strap; six gilt or nickel buttons.

**BLOUSE SHIRT.**

(WORN ONLY FROM MAY 15TH TO OCTOBER 14TH, INCLUSIVE.)

Standard blue flannel; one patch pocket on right side; white silk embroidered ornament on left breast; nickel buttons, five on the breast and two on each sleeve.

**BLUE SHIRT.**

Standard blue flannel; turn-down collar; single-breasted; closed skirt; single pointed yoke back; one outside patch pocket on left breast; sleeves with pointed cuffs having one bone button; four bone buttons on the breast.

**TROUSERS.**

Standard blue cloth, standard blue serge, standard cadet-grey cloth, or standard dark grey worsted whip cord cloth; the latter patched with same cloth on the outside below the knee; legs cut straight and of medium width; without crotch or hip pieces, but with reinforced seat when requested; six suspender buttons, also belt loops when requested; two side, half side, or top pockets, at option of employe; two hip pockets, and one watch pocket.

Standard blue cloth, or standard blue serge; legs cut straight and of medium width; without crotch or hip pieces, but with reinforced seat when requested; six suspender buttons, also belt loops when requested; two side, half side, or top pockets, at option of employe; two hip pockets, and one watch pocket; narrow white, yellow or red piping down the outside seam of each leg. For Police Department employes, an additional pocket in rear of outside seam of right leg about six inches from or below the waist, to provide for black-jack or club, at option of the employe who will furnish specifications for this pocket.

Standard black cloth; legs cut straight and of medium width; without crotch or hip pieces; six suspender buttons; two side pockets, two hip pockets, and one watch pocket.

Standard pin check denim; legs cut straight; without crotch or hip pieces; six metal suspender buttons reamed through waist band; two half top pockets, and two patch hip pockets; two inch strip of dark blue material extending from bottom along outside seam of each leg and outside of pocket to waistband.

Standard blue denim; legs cut straight; without crotch or hip pieces; six metal suspender buttons reamed through waistband; two half top pockets, and two patch hip pockets; strip of dark blue material along outside seam of each leg.

Standard white twill; legs cut straight; without crotch or hip pieces; belt loops; two straight side pockets, two hip pockets, and one watch pocket.

### **RAINCOAT. SINGLE-BREASTED.**

Closely woven navy-blue worsted material, rubberized with a very fine cured Para rubber and lined with dark plaid; 17 inch vent in back, reinforced, and closed by one button; four buttons on the breast; sleeves with adjustable storm tabs secured by buttons; military slashed pockets, one on each side, with reinforced openings in coat to permit easy access to inside clothing; convertible collar which can be worn buttoned up in military style or laid down to form lapels.

### **OVERCOATS. DOUBLE-BREASTED.**

Standard blue cloth; length, two inches below knee; roll collar  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide, lapels about  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " long; two outside lower pockets with flaps, one outside cash pocket with flap on right side, and two inside breast pockets; two rows of black ivory buttons, four buttons each.

### **DOUBLE-BREASTED, Military Style.**

Standard blue cloth; length, two inches below knee; belt across back; two outside slit pockets permitting access to back trousers pockets, two inside breast pockets (left side vertical and right side horizontal); storm collar  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " wide, with wire clasp and collar tab; either double warp black serge or all wool repellent lining, at option of the employe; either gilt or nickel buttons—five on each breast in shield design, and two buttons on each sleeve; badge loops on left breast.

**DOUBLE-BREADED.**

Standard Irish Frieze; length, two inches below knee; ulster style roll collar  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " wide, lapels about  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " long; two outside lower pockets with flaps, and two inside breast pockets; double warp black serge lining; two rows of black ivory buttons, four buttons each.

**ULSTER.****DOUBLE-BREADED.**

Standard blue cloth; length, 12" above ground; ulster style roll collar  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " wide, lapels about  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " long; muff pocket in breast on both sides, two outside lower pockets with flaps, and one outside cash pocket on right side; either double warp black serge or all wool repellent lining, at option of the employe; two rows of black ivory buttons, four buttons each.

**CAPS.**

21. Standard caps adopted and prescribed for use are as follows:

**BLUE SERGE.**

Standard light-weight blue serge; slightly bell-crowned; height  $3\frac{5}{8}$  inches; black japanned bark leather visor, sloping front, green underneath; loose inner lining for use during cold weather, which may be removed during warm weather; one gilt or nickel button on each side, two ventilators over each button; narrow gilt or white fabricoid welt around the top, lower edge and center of band or side; gilt or nickel badge.

**BLUE SERGE, MILITARY STYLE.**

Standard light-weight blue serge; height four inches in front; black japanned bark leather visor, sloping front, green underneath; one black japanned eyelet in front, to hold badge; loose inner lining for use during cold weather, which may be removed during warm weather; one gilt or nickel button on each side; two ventilators over each button; narrow gilt or white fabricoid welt around the lower edge and base of crown; woven gilt or woven silver cord extending across front of cap and visor; gilt wreath or nickel wreath badge.

**GREY CLOTH.**

Standard cadet-grey cloth; slightly bell-crowned; height  $3\frac{5}{8}$  inches; black japanned bark leather visor, sloping front, green underneath; one nickel button on each side, two ventilators over each button; narrow white fabricoid welt around the top, lower edge and center of band or side; nickel badge.

**GREY CLOTH.—(Messenger).**

Standard cadet-grey cloth; height  $3\frac{1}{2}$  inches; composition straight visor, black top, green underneath; a band of black mohair braid  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches wide, between two narrow welts of grey cloth, on side at lower edge; one nickel button on each side, two ventilators over each button; a single black leather strap,  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch wide, across the front.

**BLACK LEATHER.**

Black imitation leather; height  $3\frac{3}{8}$  inches; black imitation leather visor, sloping front, green underneath; one nickel button on each side, two ventilators over each button; nickel badge.

**RED LEATHER.**

Red imitation leather; height  $3\frac{3}{8}$  inches; composition straight visor, black top, green underneath; one nickel button on each side, two ventilators over each button; narrow white welts around top, lower edge and center of band or side; nickel badge.

**BUTTONS.**

22. Standard buttons adopted and prescribed for use are as follows:

**LARGE BUTTONS.****GILT.**

Gold-plated brass; 36 ligne size (approximately  $\frac{7}{8}$ " diam.); total weight 77 gr.; initials L. I. R. R.

**NICKEL.**

Copper nickel alloy; 36 ligne size (approximately  $\frac{7}{8}$ " diam.); total weight 77 gr.; initials L. I. R. R.

**IVORY.**

Black ivory; 45 ligne size (approximately  $1\frac{1}{8}$ " diam.); four thread holes in center.

**SMALL BUTTONS.****GILT.**

Gold-plated brass; 24 ligne size (approximately  $\frac{5}{8}$ " diam.); total weight 31 gr.; initials L. I. R. R.

**NICKEL.**

Copper nickel alloy; 24 ligne size (approximately  $\frac{5}{8}$ " diam.); total weight 31 gr.; initials L. I. R. R.

**IVORY.**

Black ivory; 24 ligne size (approximately  $\frac{5}{8}$ " diam.); four thread holes in center.

**CLOTH COVERED.**

Composition metal; black cloth covered; 28 ligne size; bottom having small tuft.

**PEARL.**

White pearl; 24 ligne size; regular shank.

**BONE.**

Black bone; 24 ligne size; four thread holes in center.

**BADGES.**

23 Standard badges adopted and prescribed for use are as follows:

**CAP BADGES.****GILT.**

Gold-plated brass, curved to contour of cap; approximately 3" long and 1 1-16" wide at widest point; black enamel letters of appropriate size, forming title or occupation of the employe.

**NICKEL.**

Copper nickel alloy, curved to contour of cap; approximately 3" long and 1 1-16" wide at widest point; black enamel letters of appropriate size, forming title or occupation of the employe.

**GILT WREATH.**

No. 18 B. & S. gauge gilding metal; gold-plated, all polished gold finish; raised monogram in center; screw button back, pin to hold wreath in place.

**NICKEL WREATH.**

No. 18 gauge nickel silver; all polished nickel finish; raised monogram in center; screw button back, pin to hold wreath in place.

**EMBROIDERED WREATH.**

On blue cloth; wreath and lettering of mat and frizze gold bullion.

**BREAST BADGES.****GILT.**

No. 14 gauge gilding metal; title in 1/8" shaded Roman letters, No. 20 gauge gilding metal; NEW YORK coat of arms in center; entire badge gold-plated; hard-soldered joint, pinned catch.

**GILT-NICKEL.**

Made of No. 14 gauge gilding metal; title in 1/8" shaded Roman letters, No. 20 gauge gilding metal; nickel-plated, except gold-plated NEW YORK coat of arms in center; hard-soldered joint, pinned catch.

**NICKEL.**

No. 14 gauge gilding metal; title in 1/8" shaded Roman letters, No. 20 gauge gilding metal; NEW YORK coat of arms in center; numbered at top in 1/8" indented numerals; entire badge nickel-plated.

**SILK EMBROIDERED.**

White silk thread, red corduroy base; keystone approximately 3" x 3", enclosing "L. I. R. R. Station Porter" and his number.

**ORNAMENTS.**

24. Standard ornaments adopted and prescribed for use are as follows:

**COLLAR ORNAMENTS.****GILT.**

Keystone, size  $\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $\frac{7}{8}$ "; No. 18 B. & S. gauge gilding metal, gold plated and all polished gold finish; skeleton monogram L. I. R. R.; pin on back to attach to collar.

**NICKEL.**

Keystone, size  $\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $\frac{7}{8}$ "; No. 18 B. & S. gauge nickel silver, all polished nickel finish; skeleton monogram L. I. R. R.; pin on back to attach to collar.

**GOLD EMBROIDERED.**

On standard blue cloth; keystone, size  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{4}$ ", border 5-32" wide, of real gold thread; enclosing monogram L. I. R. R. in letters 3-32" wide, of real gold bullion.

**SILVER EMBROIDERED.**

On standard blue cloth; keystone, size  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{4}$ ", border 5-32" wide, of real silver thread; enclosing monogram L. I. R. R. in letters 3-32" wide, of real silver bullion.

**SILK EMBROIDERED.**

White silk thread, red corduroy base; oblong in shape; maximum size about 1" x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ "; letters L. I. R. R.

**SHOULDER ORNAMENTS.**

**GOLD BAR**, Military Design.

**SLEEVE ORNAMENTS.****CHEVRON.**

Regulation New York Police—Nicholson blue cloth on dark blue cloth, with white cord edge, sewed on each sleeve, points up, half way between elbow and shoulder seam.

**GOLD LACE BAND.**

Half-inch wide; gilt wire woven, on canvas body.

**SILVER LACE BAND.**

Half-inch wide; silver wire woven, on canvas body.

**GOLD STAR.**

Five-point star; size about 1" in diameter; real gold mat bullion, embroidered on standard blue cloth.

**SILVER STAR.**

Five-point star; size about 1" in diameter; real silver mat bullion, embroidered on standard blue cloth.

BUTTONS:	Gilt.

COAT:	Double-Breasted Sack No. 1; <i>and the option of</i> Single-Breasted Sack No. 2 (Black Mohair) <i>for Summer use only.</i>
VEST:	Single-Breasted No. 1.
TROUSERS:	Without piping.
